## **Biopic:**

I trained as an undergraduate in medicine at St. Bartholomew's Hospital, London. He read for a BSc in experimental pathology, and was awarded the Award of Merit, before qualifying as a Doctor with distinction in medicine in 1990.

I commenced training in postgraduate medical specialties at the Royal Brompton Hospital and Hammersmith Hospital before gaining Membership of the Royal College of Physicians (MRCP) in 1992. I further specialised in Anaesthetics & Pain Medicine and was awarded Fellowship of the Royal College of Anaesthetists (FRCA) in 1995.

I undertook fellowships in Sydney, Australia & Seattle, USA before taking up his substantive NHS appointment at Chelsea & Westminster Teaching Hospital, London in 2000. He sat and passed the World Institute of Pain Interventional Exams and was awarded the Fellowship of Interventional Pain Practice (FIPP) in October 2005.

At Chelsea & Westminster Hospital, I led the Clinical Pain Management team involved in acute postoperative & chronic pain conditions (2002-2005). I hold the post of Honorary Senior Lecturer at Imperial College, London. I sat on a number of hospital, regional, and national committees. I took the post of council member for the interventional pain practice specialist interest group of the British Pain Society in 2005.

I lead the spinal cord stimulator team at Chelsea & Westminster Hospital. I sit on the integrated spinal multidisciplinary team at Imperial Health Care Trust.

My professional interests include assessment and treatment of spinal conditions, interventional and regional anaesthesia, the treatment of the chronic painful conditions of neck, shoulder, low back, complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS) and persistent postoperative surgical pain.

## **Medicolegal Experience:**

I attended Professional Solution report writing & advanced report writing in 2005. I attended the Clinical Negligence conference by BPP 2010 and regular annual medicolegal conferences. I attended the 2<sup>nd</sup> Pain Expert conference in October 2016 and the 4<sup>th</sup> Pain Expert conference in October 2018. I have also lectured to several law firms and medicolegal conferences on medicolegal aspects of pain and spines.

I have prepared expert evidence for the UK courts for the last 12 years encompassing a wide range of issues including medical negligence, whiplash, cauda equine syndrome, complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS), persistent surgical pain, and nerve injury following anaesthesia and nerve blocks.

I have been and continue to be instructed to provide expert evidence on behalf of both claimants and defendants. I have also prepared medical reports on behalf of both parties on a joint instruction basis. I have attended court.

My claimant to defendant ratio was approximately 60:40 at the time of updating his curriculum vitae.
