EXPERT'S DETAILS:

Professional qualifications: I qualified with an MB,BChir at Cambridge University Medical School in 2008. I wrote my undergraduate thesis on Dietary zinc intake and Brain Cancer in Adults. I trained in Anaesthesia and Pain Management at the Imperial School of Anaesthesia in West London rotating through national centres of excellence. I became a Fellow of the Royal College of Anaesthetists (FRCA) in 2013 and Faculty of Pain Medicine (FFPMRCA) in 2017. I gained a place on the Specialist Register for Anaesthesia in August 2017.

NHS Consultant appointments: I was appointed Consultant in Anaesthetics and Pain Management at Imperial College NHS Healthcare Trust in August 2017. The Imperial Pain Management Centre provides a multidisciplinary service with doctors, nurses, clinical psychologists, and physiotherapists. I am the departmental lead for clinical audit, patient and radiation safety.

Private practice: I have been treating private patients with chronic pain since 2018 at The Thames View, London. I also treat elite athletes suffering from pain related to sports injuries at the Blackberry Sports Clinic in Milton Keynes. I also provide service in the community setting as a member of InHealth Pain Management Solutions.

Experience: My extensive training and broad practice means I have experience in the management of a wide range of painful conditions including those that can result from personal injury. This includes chronic conditions such as complex regional pain syndrome, neuropathic pain, lumbar spinal pain & sciatica, thoracic spinal pain, cervical spinal pain & whiplash, shoulder pain, knee pain, hip pain, pelvic pain, pain after surgery & trauma and complex headaches. I take referrals from the peripheral nerve injury unit for non-cold freezing injury at Hammersmith Hospital. I regularly attend multidisciplinary team meetings with my colleagues in orthopaedics, sports medicine, spinal surgery and neurosurgery.

I have proficiency in the assessment, diagnosis and treatment of the most complex patients. I review more than 1800 patients per year in my whole practice. I provide second opinions to at least 100 patients a year. I have extensive experience in a variety of physical, psychological, pharmacological and interventional pain management techniques. I have been mentored by pain management experts in the field both within the UK and abroad who regularly appraise my practice. I regularly perform fluoroscopic and ultrasound guided interventional procedures which include but are not limited to: epidurals (transforaminal, interlaminar), facet joint injections, sacroiliac joint injections, medial branch blocks, continuous and pulsed radiofrequency ablation, botox and steroid injections. I have a special interest in radiofrequency treatments for the cervical spine and the use of Qutenza application for non-cold freezing injuries.

Teaching and Presentations: I am an Angoff scorer for the Faculty of Pain Medicine Examinations (FFPMRCA). I have presented at national and regional meetings of the Royal College of Anaesthetists, Patient Safety and Liaison Group, Faculty of Pain Medicine and the London School of Anaesthesia.
