Professional qualifications: I read medicine at Jesus College, Cambridge. I completed specialist training in anaesthesia within the East of England which included a paediatric anaesthesia fellowship at Great Ormond Street Hospital, London. I was awarded the Fellowship of the Royal College of Anaesthetists (FRCA) in 2003 and was placed on the specialist register in 2007. I was awarded the Fellowship of the Faculty of Pain Medicine of the Royal College of Anaesthetists (FFPMRCA) in 2014 after training in pain medicine as a consultant. This included subspeciality training in paediatric pain medicine in London, Sheffield and Leeds.

NHS Consultant appointments: I was appointed as a consultant at Addenbrooke's Hospital, Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust in 2007. I currently divide my NHS time between adult and paediatric pain medicine. I am the lead clinician for paediatric pain medicine and have both inpatient and outpatient sessions. We provide multidisciplinary assessment and management of children with chronic pain, including where appropriate pain interventions for cancer related pain and CRPS. I also have outpatient and procedure lists for adult patients. I participate in the paediatric anaesthesia on call rota.

Private practice: I hold private consultations at the Nuffield Health Cambridge Hospital and the Spire Cambridge Lea Hospital.

Clinical experience: I have considerable experience in managing complex pain conditions in all age groups including spinal pain, sciatica, complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS) and pain related to trauma and surgery.

Presentations and Teaching: I am currently the Faculty Tutor (Pain) in Cambridge and the Regional Adviser for Pain Medicine for the East of England. I currently sit on the Training and Assessment Committee of the Faculty of Pain Medicine. I have co-authored the 'Managing Chronic Pain in Children and Young People' section of the Faculty of Pain Medicine's publication Core Standards for Pain Management Services in the UK (2021).
