## **Dr Christopher Green MB BCh FRCA FFPMRCA**

### **Consultant in Pain Medicine**

**Professional qualifications:** I read medicine at University Hospital of Wales College of Medicine (UWCM), Cardiff and was awarded MB BCh in 2000. After completing a range of medical, surgical, and emergency medicine positions in the UK as well as a Medical Registrar position in New Zealand, I completed specialist training in Anaesthesia in Oxford and was elected Fellow of the Royal College of Anaesthetists (FRCA) in 2008. I gained advanced training in Pain Medicine through completion of an accredited Fellowship in chronic cancer and non-cancer pain management and neuromodulation in Ottawa, Canada in 2011. I was subsequently awarded FFPMRCA in 2011 and placed on the Specialist Register in 2012.

**NHS Consultant appointments:** I was appointed a substantive consultant at Addenbrooke's Hospital, Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Trust in 2012 and relocated to Derriford Hospital, University Hospitals Plymouth, in 2017 where I was Clinical Director from 2018 until 2022. Both are multidisciplinary tertiary academic centres seeing a full spectrum of chronic pain conditions.

**Private practice:** I hold private consultations at the Nuffield Hospital, Plymouth and the Ramsay Duchy Hospital, Truro.

**Clinical experience:** I have been practicing Pain Medicine since 2010, and as a Consultant alongside anaesthetic practice since 2012. I have been a full-time Pain Consultant since 2018, managing a wide range of painful primary and secondary chronic pain conditions in an outpatient setting. I have a special interest in head and neck pain for which I am clinical lead. I have established a tertiary-level regional MDT for chronic facial pain. I am clinical lead for Neuromodulation (Spinal Cord Stimulation). I manage cancer pain patients and intrathecal drug delivery implantable pumps (ITDD) for cancer pain. My experience includes management of headaches, facial pain, neck pain, spinal pain, neuropathic pain (including post-injury and complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS)), chronic musculoskeletal pain, and chronic widespread pain.

**Special interests:** Interventional management of chronic pain. I am experienced in assessing the role of biopsychosocial factors in the causation and maintenance of chronic pain conditions especially where these may act as barriers to effective rehabilitation by interventional techniques. I believe in establishing accurate pain diagnoses according to World Health Organisation ICD-11 to facilitate targeted and individual patient management decisions. I recognise the need for active patient engagement in making the changes necessary to improve their success from pain management strategies to restore lost function. I have particular interests in the management of headache and facial pain, neck and spinal pain, neuropathic pain and complex regional pain syndrome, and pain after injury.

**Presentations and Teaching:** I have previously held the position of Local Pain Medicine Educational Supervisor in Cambridge. I have presented at local and national meetings and taught at undergraduate, postgraduate and specialist levels in the UK and abroad.
