Professional qualifications: I gained a BA at Cambridge University in 1996 and subsequently MBBS at Royal Free Hospital School of Medicine in 1999. I became a member of the Royal College of Psychiatrists (MRCPsych) in 2004 and qualified as a Consultant Psychiatrist in 2013 with specialisms in Old Age, General Adult Psychiatry and Rehabilitation Psychiatry.

Consultant appointments: I worked as a Consultant in Old Age Psychiatry and Rehabilitation Psychiatry in Harrow, Central and Northwest London Foundation Trust from 2013 to 2014. I was employed as a Consultant Psychiatrist in Priory Hospital, Hemel Hempstead from 2014 to 2021, where my practice focused on the treatment of NHS funded patients with complex psychiatric conditions. I was Clinical Director of the Priory Group Rehabilitation Clinical Network from 2018 to 2019. I was appointed as a Consultant Psychiatrist in Rehabilitation Psychiatry in Central Northwest London NHS Trust in 2021. I have been a part-time Honorary Consultant Psychiatrist at the Traumatic Stress Clinic in Camden and Islington NHS Trust since September 2023.

Clinical Experience: My general psychiatric experience includes assessment and treatment of people with psychosis, mood disorders, post-traumatic stress disorder, anxiety, dementia, acquired brain injury and learning disability. I have experience in the assessment and treatment of complex needs, including major psychiatric disorders complicated by substance misuse, alcohol and personality disorder. I have conducted frequent assessments of capacity in my clinical role.

National Roles: I am a member of the AIMS-Rehab Advisory Group (a peer-accreditation service) at the Royal College of Psychiatrists. I sat on the Executive Committee of the Rehabilitation and Social Psychiatry Faculty at the Royal College of Psychiatrists from 2015 to 2020. I have presented and chaired sessions at national meetings of the Royal College of Psychiatrists.

Medicolegal report writing experience: I have prepared medicolegal reports for criminal litigation cases, coroner's inquests, personal injury litigation (mainly defendant) and Section 49 reports.

Courtroom experience and provision of oral evidence: I have extensive experience in presenting evidence in Mental Health Tribunals.
